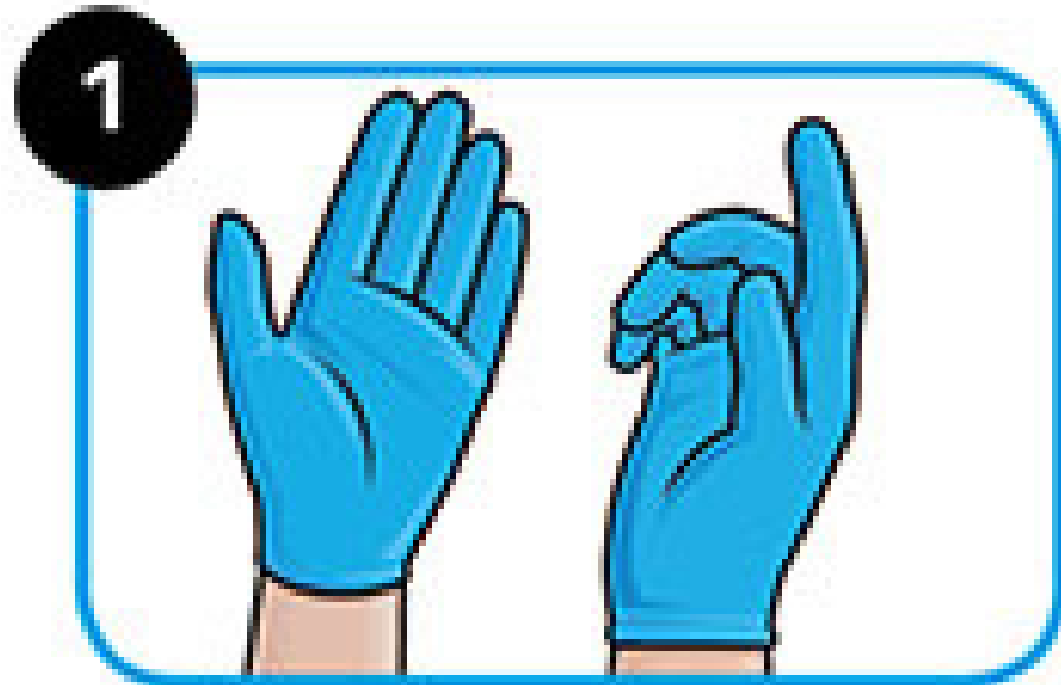
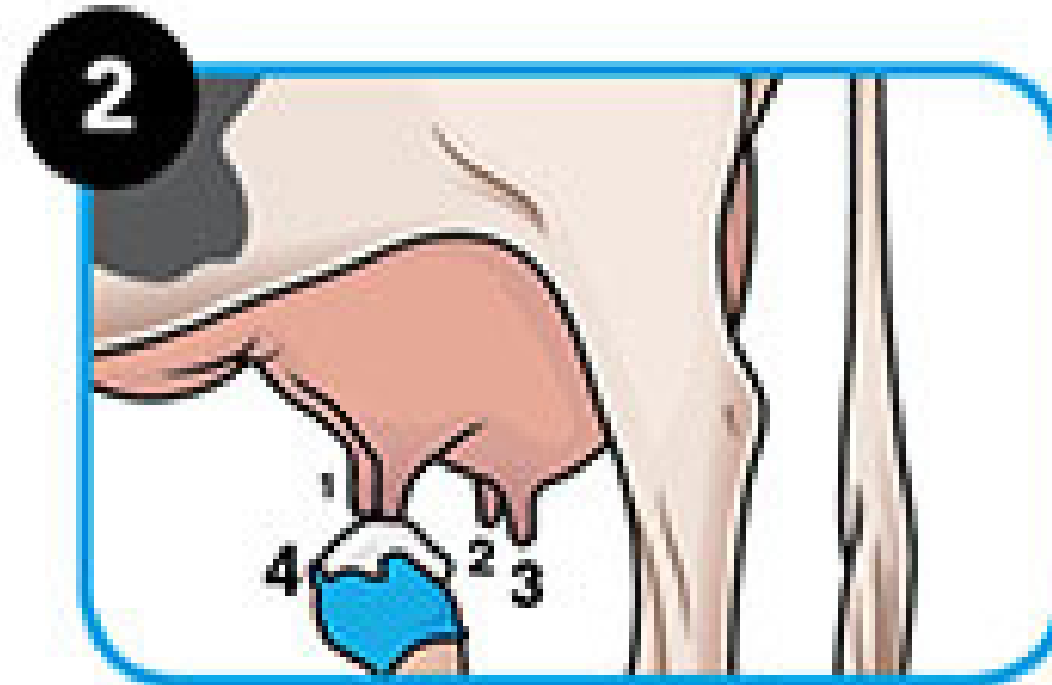


# How to give Inter-teat Treatments



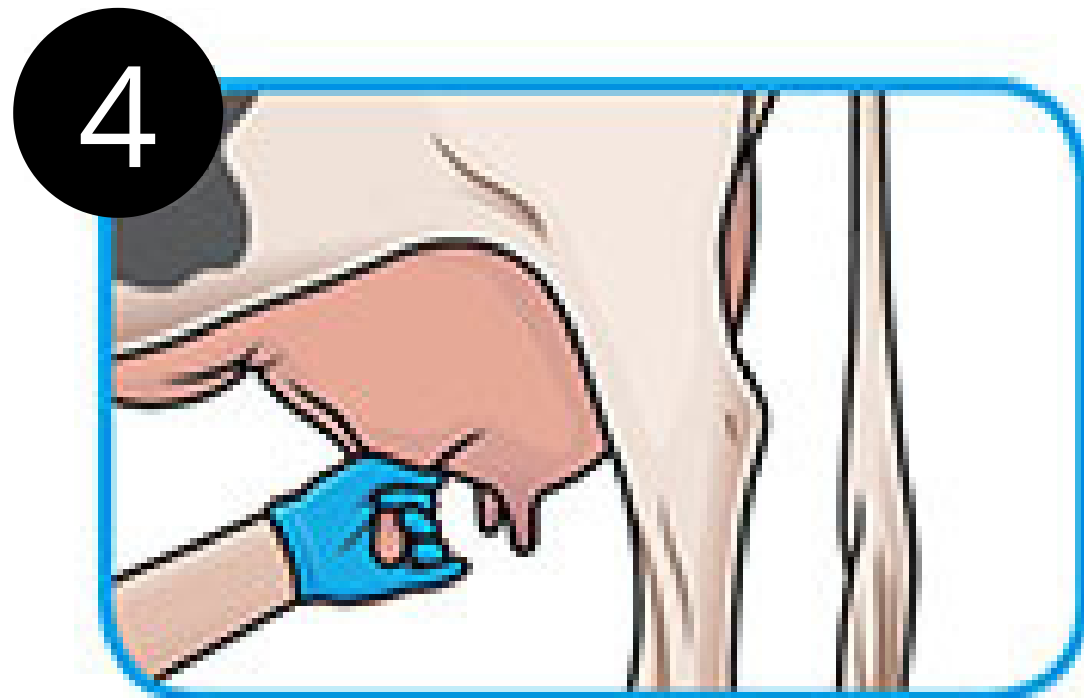
**1** Hygiene is important in this process. Wear gloves and be conscious of syringe location.



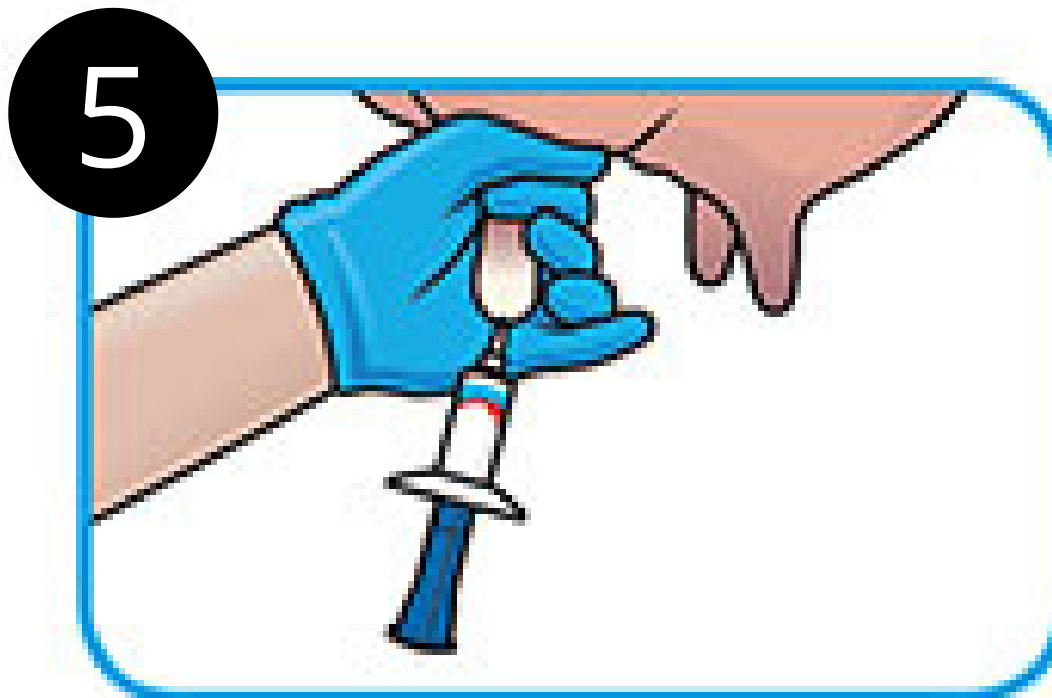
**2** Gently scrub the end of each teat with alcohol pad.



**3** Lay out the needed number of tubes in a clean area.

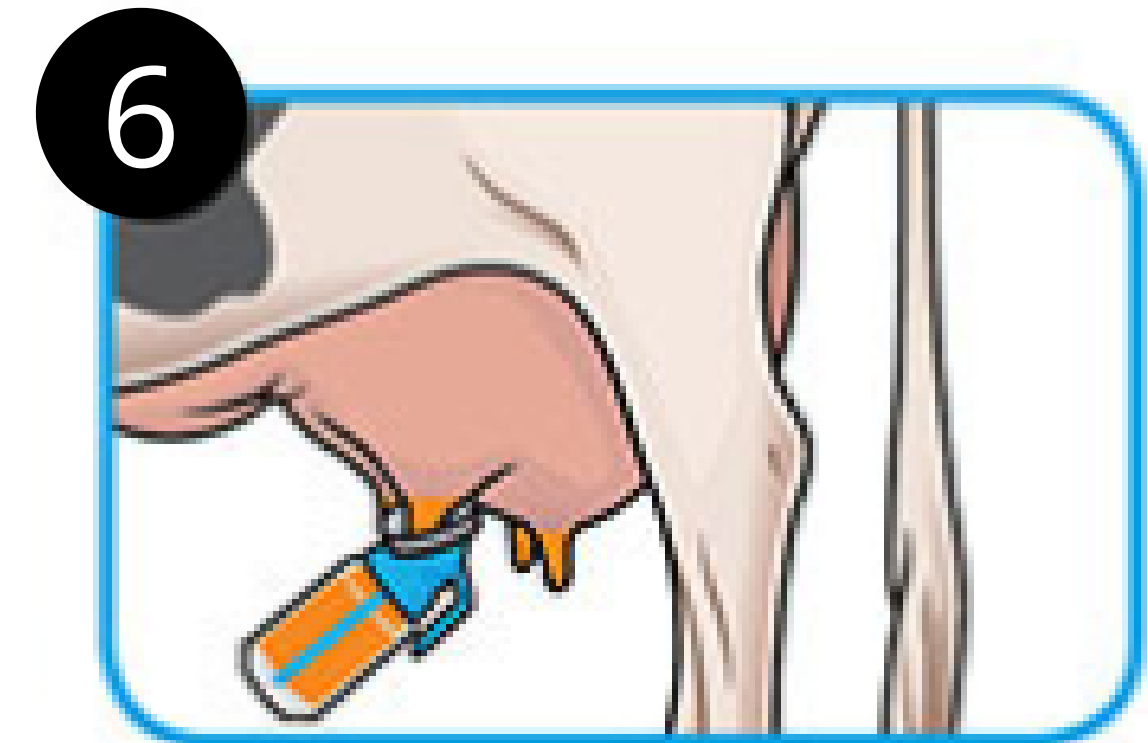


**4** Pinch the teat at the udder base, and gently pull down, not releasing the teat... this creates a better opening for treatment.



**5** Remove the cap and insert the tip of the applicator into the teat opening and dispense the full tube of medication.

**Repeat  
steps  
4 and 5  
for each  
teat.**



**6** Apply betadine/post-dip to teats.
